Today's card uses the new Nature's Prints bundle from the new 2022-2023 Annual Catalog. I let the designer series paper speak in this card! The paper is so beautiful it can stand all on its own!

Products used from the new catalog which are available on May 3, 2022 to customers include:

- Nature's Prints Bundle (Stamp Set and Dies)
- Sun Prints 12" x 12" Designer Series Paper
- Starry Sky Cardstock
- Starry Sky Stampin Pad
- Starry Sky Metallic Woven Ribbon

1. Card Cuts:

- Card Base - Cut 1 Starry Sky cardstock to 8-1/2" x 5-1/2", score at 4-1/4"
- Panel - Cut 1 Basic White cardstock to 4-1/8" x 5-3/8"
- DSP Panel - Cut 1 Sun Prints 12" x 12" Designer Series Paper to 4" x 5-1/4"
- Scraps of Basic White cardstock for die cut floral images and sentiment label
- Inside Panel - Cut 1 Basic White cardstock to 4" x 5-1/4"

- Envelope Flap - Cut 1 coordinating DSP to 2-3/4" x 6"
2. Die cut two medium length floral images from the Nature's Prints die set, and die cut one small floral image in Basic White cardstock.
 3. Stamp the sentiment onto a piece of scrap white cardstock, and die cut using the sentiment label from the Nature's Prints die set.
 4. Using the Gingko floral image, stamp this image in Starry Sky ink onto the lower right of the inside panel. Adhere the panel to the inside of the card.
 5. Using the Gingko floral image, stamp this image in Starry Sky ink onto the lower right envelope front.
 6. Adhere the DSP panel to the white panel, then adhere this unit to the card front.
 7. Cut a 6" piece of Starry Sky Metallic Woven Ribbon. Place a small amount of Stampin' Seal onto the DSP card front in the upper left-hand corner - approximately 1" from the top of the DSP and 1-1/2" from the left side of the DSP. Fold the ribbon in half, pinching at the fold, and fray the ribbon. Because the ribbon is woven and only 1/8" wide, it frays easily. I used the tip of my snips to fray the ribbon. Adhere the frayed ribbon onto the Stampin' Seal that you placed on the DSP/card front and trim the ends if necessary.
 8. Using a small amount of glue, glue the white die cut floral images to the same area where the ribbon is attached, placing glue on only the stem ends. The die cut florals are facing down and I fanned them out, placing a larger image on the left and right and the smaller image in the middle.
 9. Using Stampin' Dimensionals, adhere the sentiment label to the front of the card over the ribbon and floral attachment points.
 10. Glue the coordinating piece of DSP to the envelope flap and fussy cut around the flap to finish the envelope.


