


Cottage Rose Get Well Card

This card is a CAS (Create and Share) from the May 2022-April 2023 Annual Catalog. I was looking for some ideas and this card caught my eye. I changed the card up a bit from the one shown in the catalog. The beautiful Abigail Rose 12" x 12" Designer Series Paper makes this card, along with the beautiful flower image from the Cottage Flowers Dies set! This card is quick to produce, too!

1. Card Cuts:

- Card Base - Cut 1 Smoky Slate cardstock to 8-1/2" x 5-1/2", score at 4-1/4"
- DSP Mat - Cut 1 Petal Pink Stripe print from the Abigail Rose DSP to 5-3/8" x 4-1/8"
- DSP Panel - Cut 1 Smoky Slate Leaf print from the Abigail Rose DSP to 5" x 3-3/4"
- Scrap of Basic White measuring approximately 5-1/2" x 4" for die cutting
- Inside Panel - Cut 1 Basic White cardstock to 5-3/8" x 4-1/8"
- Envelope Flap - Cut 1 coordinating DSP to 6" x 2-1/2"

2. Start by adhering the DSP Mat (Petal Pink stripe print) to the card front.

3. The flower on the card front was assembled using pieces from the largest die from the Cottage Flowers Dies set. Use this large die and cut from Basic White cardstock. Note: This is the die that cuts out individual pieces of flowers, leaves and a stem. Once die cut,

pull out the largest flower piece and two medium size flower pieces, one small flower piece and the stem with leaves piece. You will use Stampin' Blends to color these images.

- Use the light shade of a Petal Pink Stampin' Blend to color all four of the flower pieces. Then use the dark shade of a Petal Pink Stampin' Blend to darken each flower piece around the bottoms of each piece. Once the flower is assembled, you should be able to see the darker areas of each flower piece with the tops of the flower pieces being lighter in color. Use a Color Lifter to slightly lighten the tops of the flower pieces.
 - Use Crumb Cake Stampin' Blends to color in the stem and leaves piece that you die cut.
4. Arrange the flower pieces to form a larger flower and adhere the pieces together. Lay the two medium size flower pieces on top of the larger flower piece and slightly overlap the pieces and adhere. Lay the smallest flower piece on top of the two medium size flower pieces in the center of the newly formed flower. The bottom of the smallest flower piece should sit below the bottoms of the other flower pieces. Adhere. Adhere the newly formed flower to the stem.
 5. Adhere the flower and stem unit to the DSP Panel measuring 5" x 3-3/4". Place to the right and center of the panel.
 6. Using the sentiment "feel better real soon" from the Cottage Rose Stamp Set, stamp the sentiment directly onto the DSP panel in Early Espresso ink. Stamp towards the center of the panel and to the left of the adhered flower.
 7. Using a length of Linen Thread, wrap the thread around the bottom 3rd of the DSP Panel once and adhere the ends of the thread to the back of the DSP panel using Stampin' Seal. Adhere the DSP Panel to the DSP Mat. Tie an additional single bow using Linen Thread and attach the bow to the card front using a Mini Glue Dot. Place the bow just under the flower and on the line of Linen Thread running across the card front.
 8. On the white inside panel, use the largest flower image from the Cottage Rose Stamp Set, and stamp this image onto the panel in the lower left corner using Smoky Slate ink. The image is only partially stamped onto the panel and was not colored in.
 9. Stamp the same large flower image partially onto the envelope front using Smoky Slate ink.
 10. Adhere the piece of coordinating DSP to the envelope flap and cut around the flap to finish off the envelope.
 11. Adhere several Iridescent Pearls Basic Jewels to the card front to finish off the card.


